HOLE NUMBER 5 - WOMEN'S CLOSEST TO THE PIN - Closest-to-the-pin is won by the golfer whose tee shot comes to rest closest to the hole. To win the competition, the ball must have stopped on the green. Any balls off the green are ignored, even if they are the closest. The shooter should move the marker to the location of the shot and write her name on the sheet in the marker.

DIANNE RICE!

HOLE NUMBER 6 - MEN'S LONGEST DRIVE - the shooter of the longest drives on Hole 6 should move his marker to the location of the drive, and write his name on the sheet in the marker. The golfer's shot must be in the fairway when it comes to rest.

TED AYERST!

HOLE NUMBER 14 - MEN'S CLOSEST TO THE PIN - Closest-to-the-pin is won by the golfer whose tee shot comes to rest closest to the hole. To win the competition, the ball must have stopped on the green. ALLI RICE!

HOLE NUMBER 18 - LONGEST PUTT - the shooter of the longest putt should move the marker to roughly where the putt was shot from and write his or her name on the sheet in the marker, as well as the approximate length.

JIMMY BARRETT!

HOLE NUMBER 18 - STRAIGHTEST SHOT - a white chalk line runs the length of this fairway. The object is to be the golfer that hits the ball closest to the line. The shooter of the closest shot should move the marker to the location of the shot and write his or her name on the sheet in the marker.
